
1. \*UNPLUG THE UNIT SO THAT NO POWER IS PRESENT\*




- 2. If the unit is suspended using 3/8" threaded rod into the handle assemblies, uninstall the unit so that you can remove the fan side access cover.
- 3. Remove the Torx screws that hold the front control access cover in place:



4. Remove the Torx screws that hold the fan side access cover in place – screws are located on side of panel, around handles, and on top side of panel:











- 5. Remove handle trim pieces. Then remove fan side access cover to expose fan assembly.
- 6. Disconnect fan wire harness plug:






7. Remove Torx screws and nuts that hold the fan assembly bracket to the unit. Then remove bracket and fan motor assembly as one whole assembly from the unit:



8. With fan motor assembly removed from unit, remove the Torx screw from wire clamp securing wire to bracket. Then remove the 4 Torx screws that hold the fan motor to the fan bracket and remove fan motor:



9. Install new fan motor on bracket and reinstall in reverse order. \*NOTE: ONCE FAN BRACKET IS REINSTALLED, MAKE SURE THAT THE FAN MOTOR BLADE IS NOT RUBBING ON THE INNER FAN SHROUD - IF SO, READJUST FAN BRACKET\*

- 10. Reinstall wiring plug, fan side access cover, handle trim plates, and front control access cover.
- 11. If adequate power is available at site of repair, test unit operation before reinstalling the unit.
